

Your Voice Monthly Omnibus Survey Key results for September 2023



Summary

<u>Methodology</u>

Your Voice September 2023

Type: An omnibus, controlled-access online CFIB survey.

Active dates: September 7-21, 2023

Results: Based on responses from 2,687 CFIB members who are owners of Canadian independent businesses, from all sectors and regions of the country.

For comparison purposes, a probability samples with the same number of respondents would have a margin of error of +/-1.9%, 19 times out of 20.

Totals may not add up to 100% due to: 1) rounding, or; 2) respondents being able to select more than one answer choice.

 More than half of small business owners (57%) are optimistic about their business performance over the next 12 months. 	4-5
 The cost of doing business (76%), taxes (61%), labour shortages (51%) and labour policies (50%) are currently the top concerns for small businesses. 	6-8
CEBA loan	
 Of those that accessed the Canada Emergency Business Account (CEBA) loan, 7 in 10 (70%) small business owners report they have yet to begin repayment. 	10
Rising interest rates	
 Rising interest rates have negatively impacted more than half of small business owners (56%), with increased borrowing costs topping the list of negative impacts. 	12-13



Small business outlook over the next year





• Very optimistic • Somewhat optimistic




CEBA loan



Impact of rising interest rates on small businesses




